## What the MFPA Act Does:

- ✓ Creates a federal Accountability Committee
- ✓ Establishes protections under the Violence Against Women Act (VAWA)
- ✓ Provides \$800M/year for housing, legal aid, therapy
- ✓ Expands survivor support via trusted nonprofit partnerships

↑ 91% since 2015

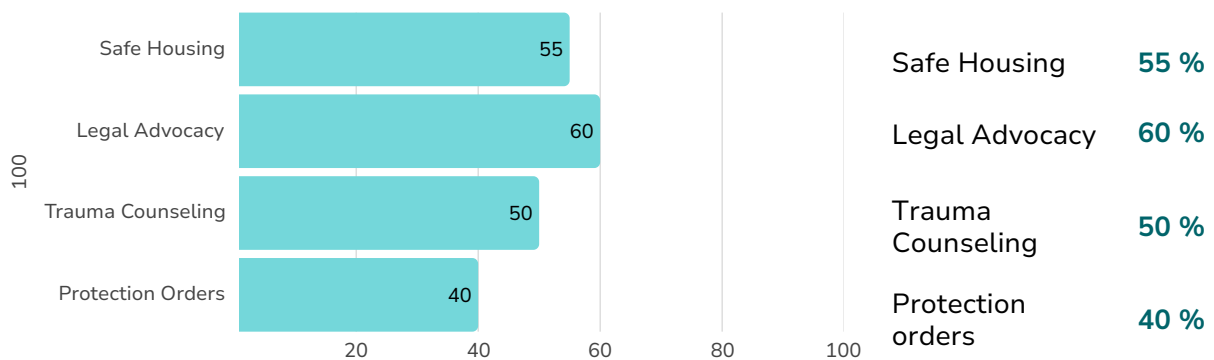


**Over 40%**
