Remembering why?

Who is affected? CDC Statistics

- Data of US crime reports suggest that 16% (about 1 in 6) of murders are killed by an intimate partner
- Over 40% of female homicides victims in U.S are killed by IPV and someone they knew, 14% of men experience physical injuries from IPV
- Nearly **700,000 children** are abused in the U.S each year.
- About 120 million girls worldwide (slightly more than 1 in 10) have experienced forced sex or other forced sexual acts at some point in their lives
